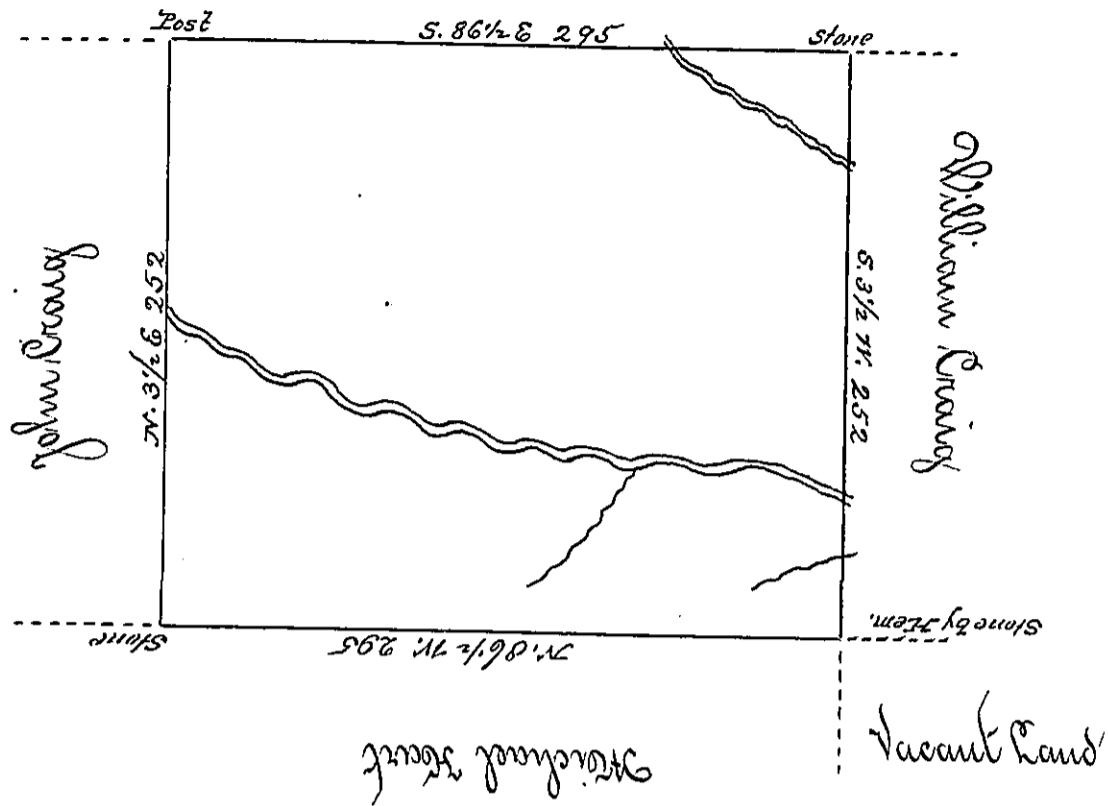


State of New York
