Note, It appears by a Certif<sup>e</sup> of Rich<sup>d</sup>. Hockley dated that Peter Wolf paid £10 into ye. R. G. Office ye. 3<sup>d</sup> Octo<sup>r</sup>. 1742 to obtain a w<sup>t</sup> for 200<sup>ac</sup> which was never completed.
