



In pursuance of an Order No. 2130 Dated April the 5th 1769 Survey'd for ^{Thomas} John Pollock the above described tract of land containing two hundred & forty five acres & 90 perches with an allowance proportioned to 6 percent Situate near Forbes's old Road, adjoining Austin Bickley's land in Bedford County, Survey'd October 23rd 1771.
