



By virtue of a Warrant Dated at Philadelphia on the fifteenth Day of April Annoque Domini 1752 Granted to Jacob Besecker the above described Tract of Land situate in Harlborough Township in the County of Philadelphia and Province of Pennsylvania Containing One Hundred and four Acres and sixteen Perches of Land together with the usual Allowance at six per cent for Roads was formerly surveyed for the said Jacob Besecker... But now resurveyed for John Meckerlin on the first day of September Anno 1760---
