



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries dated the first day of August 1754 surveyed into David Cannon a tract of Land situate near Schickon in the County of Bucks Beginning at a post a Corner of James Dickens Land thence by Vacant Land North East one hundred and ninety perches to a Hickery a Corner of a Tract laid out to Griffith Davies thence by the same North West one hundred and thirty four perches to a post thence by Vacant Land South East one hundred and ninety perches to a post in a line of said Dickens Land thence by the same South West one hundred & thirty four perches to the place of Beginning Containing one hundred and fifty acres with the usual Allowance of six per cent
