



A Draught of a small Tract of 2 1/2 acres of Land & allowance as usual, situate on a Branch of Octoraro Creek in Oxford Township, Chester County, which was surveyed the 29<sup>th</sup> of the 4<sup>th</sup> mo 1759 to William Bunting, in Pursuance of a warrant dated the 18<sup>th</sup> of the same Instant Beginning at a Corner Post of W<sup>m</sup> Calbraith's Land & of the said Bunting's other Land standing about 5 perches southward of his Mill-Dam & Damming thence the several Courses & Distances above described laid down by a scale of 40 p to an Inch the 25<sup>th</sup> 6 mo 1759
