



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries dated the second day of March 1733 Surveyed unto Sebastian Griff a tract of Land situate in Oley in the County of Philada. Beginning at a post a Corner of Robert Stapletons Land thence by the same and Vacant Land South Seventy degrees East Three hundred and forty Eight perches to a Corner Stone thence by Vacant Land, North Twenty degrees East Seventy ~~two~~ perches to a Corner stone thence by Vacant Land North Seventy degrees west one hundred and forty ~~two~~ perches to a post a Corner of John Goders Land thence by the same North West Two hundred and ~~two~~ twelve perches to a post by a Great Road leading to Philada. thence by the said Road South Twenty Six degrees west one hundred and twenty perches to a Small Hickory a Corner of Abraham Ashmans land thence by the same South Twenty degrees west forty perches to the place of Beginning containing one hund hundred and ninety Seven acres with the usual allowance of Six pcent.
