



By virtue of a Warrant from the Commrs. of Property bearing date the 20th. day of the first month 1716 Surveyed & laid out unto Joseph Growdon a Tract of Land in the County of Bucks Beginning at a post in John Streper's Line on the west side of a Creek called Tohickon from thence extending by the sd. line south east over the sd. Creek four hundred perches to a post, then south west 260 perches to a black oak, then north west 264 perches to a post, Then north eighteen degrees east (all by vacant Lands) 292 perches to the beginning containing five hundred and forty acres Laid out the first day of the 6th. month 1716
