



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries dated the first day of June 1734 Surveyed unto Isaac Walton a tract of land situated on the South side of three mile Run in the County of Bucks Beginning at a white Elm tree standing on the Bank of the said Run thence by land of Jacob Harman South East two hundred perches & by Vacant land the same course forty perches to a post thence by Vacant land North East one hundred and five perches to a Hickery tree thence by land laid out to James Dicken North west Two hundred & four perches and by land laid out to Peter Partridge forty perches to an alder tree standing on the bank of sd. Run thence up the same to the place of Beginning Containing one hundred and fifty acres with the usual allowance of Six pcent. Surveyed 7<sup>th</sup> 23<sup>d</sup> 1734.
