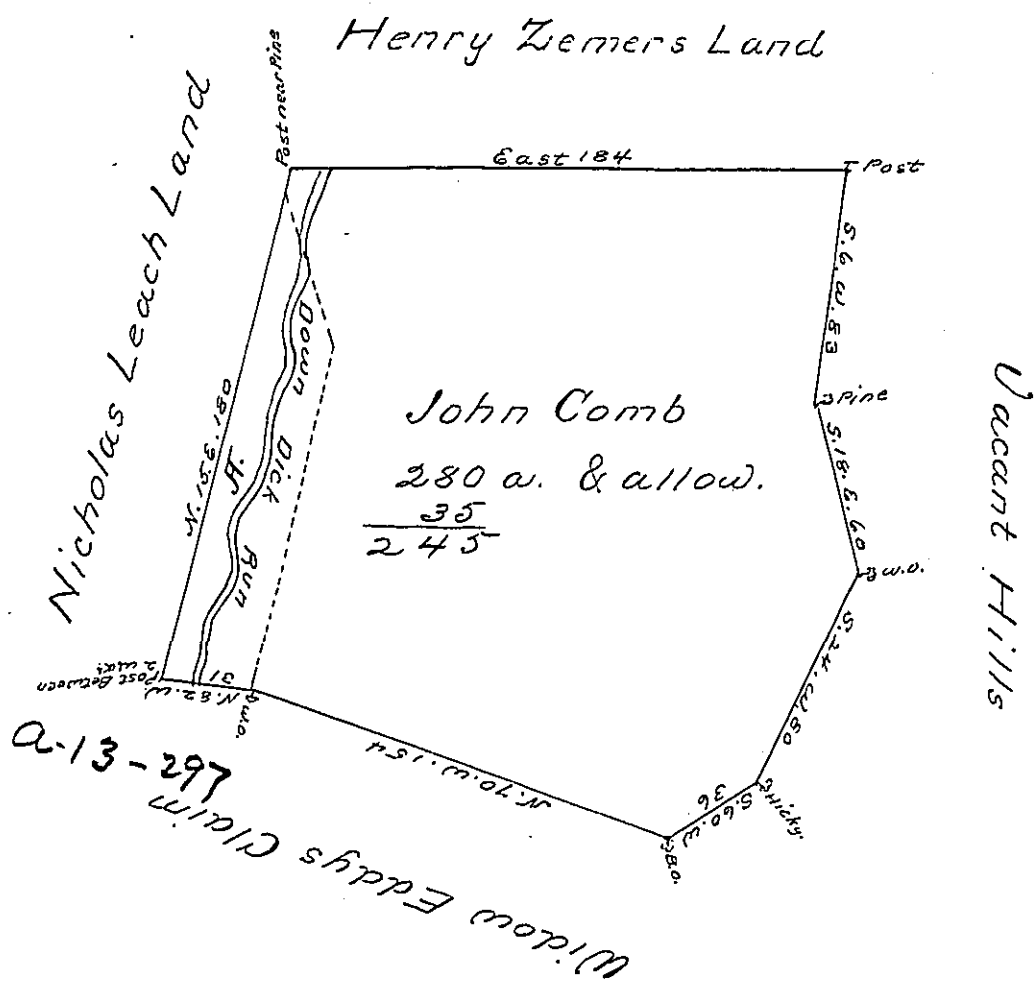


The overlaid bounds in this survey is found to be other than those set to the owner of this tract.
