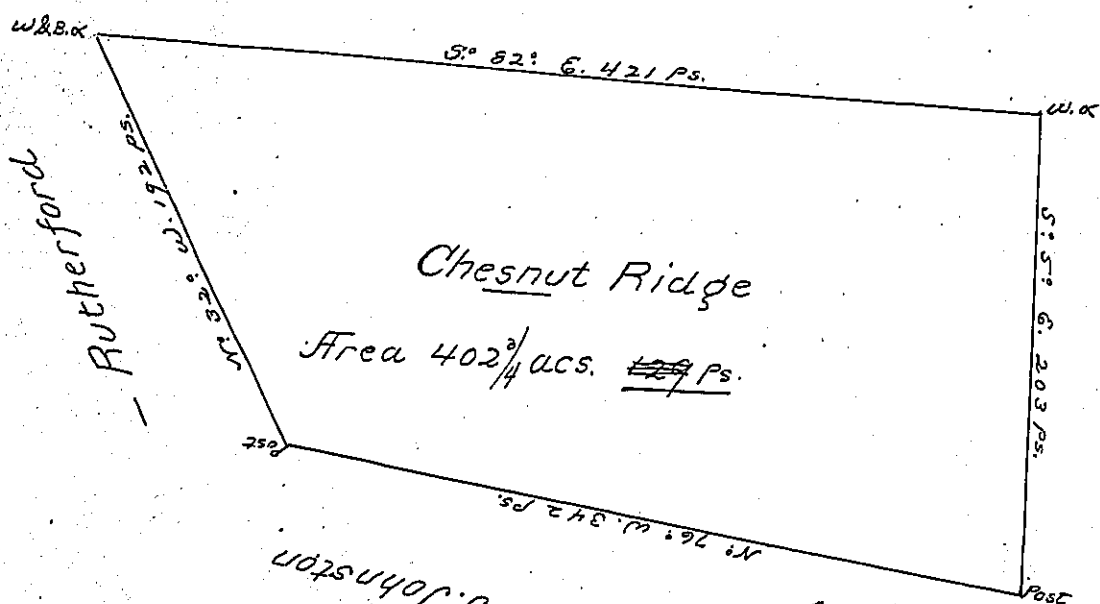

Note - the name Zach<sup>a</sup> altered to Wm after ye instance of Mr. Allison who obtained a Patent for a Ret<sup>ca</sup> in ye name of Zach<sup>a</sup> last Sept. and both tracts belonging to one man he (Mrs. Lukens Esqr. & Genl.) alledged ~~it~~ it was no matter as the mistake originated with ye Ret<sup>ca</sup> in ye manner of Returning.
