By Virtue of a warrant from the Proprietaries dated the 24th day of January 1733 Survey'd unto John Rees the <sup>31</sup>~~24~~th of the same month a Tract of Land Situate on a Small Branch of Brandywine in Chester County Beginning at a Black Oak on the point of a Well, thence N. S. West crossing the sd. Branch 224 pches to another B. Oak thence N. N. West 128 pches to a Black Oak thence North 74° 4 a half east 226 pches to a Black oak, thence S. S. East 100 pches to the Beginning containing one Hundred and fifty acres and the usual allowance for roads.
