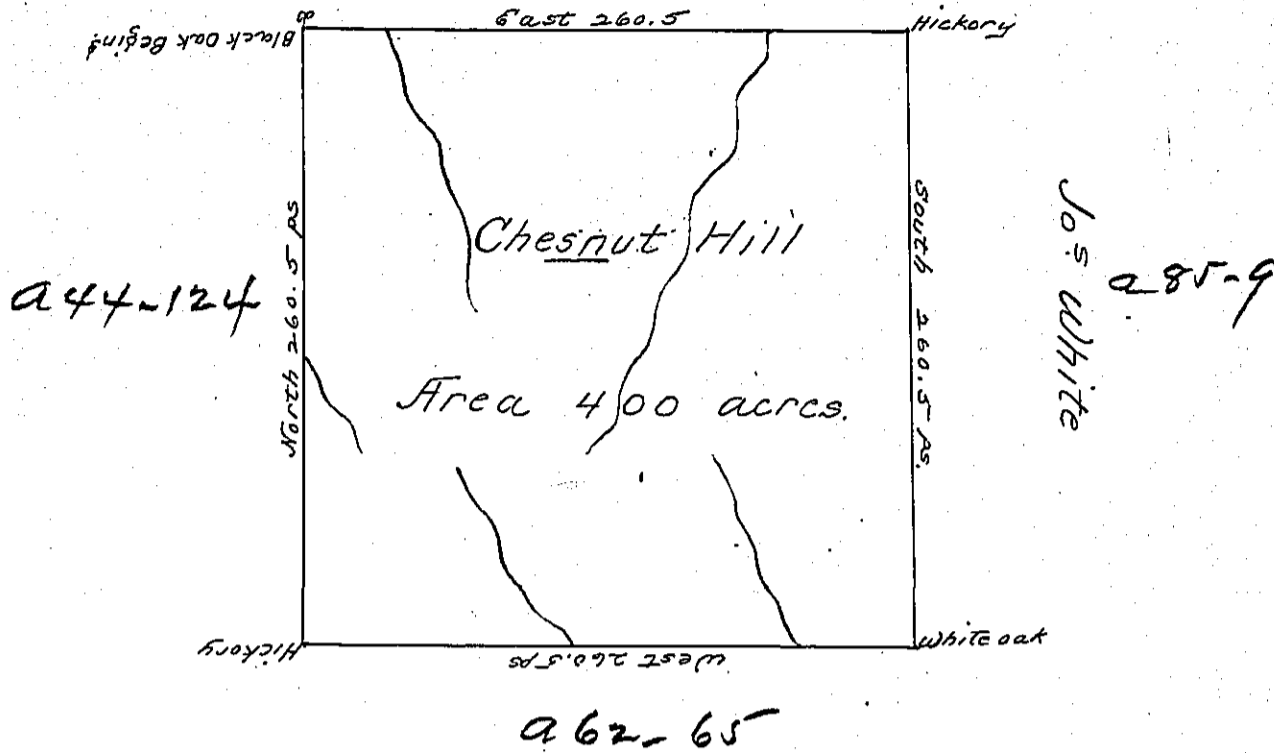

Sept. 1784 Situate on the Dunkard fork of Wheeling waters in Washington County adjoining land Surveyd for James White (called Chestnut Hill) containing four hundred acres with usual allow<sup>ce</sup> of 6 percent.
