



A Draught of a Tract of Land situate on the waters of Loyalsock Creek, adjoining land of John Ashmead Junr. & others in Loyalsock Township in the County of Northumberland - Survey'd on the 7th day of November 1788, for John Ashmead Senr. in pursuance of his Warrant bearing date the first day of July 1784. Containing Four Hundred & nine acres & one quarter & the allowance of six poles for Roads &c.

This warrant was remov'd from the waters of Catawassa Creek, the land being Appropriated, as appears by a Certificate under the hand of the Deputy Surveyor of that District &c.
