



The above is a Draught of a Survey made April the 8th 1794 in pursuance of a warrant granted to John Wilkins Jun^r for 400 acres of Land dated the twentieth day of February 1794. Situate on the north side of the Hockens River adjoining to the East the line between Jones and Cummings District on the waters of Pine Creek in District No. 9. Called Wilkins's Bottom, containing Four hundred acres together with the usual allowance of six per Cent for Roads.
