 Robt. Stevenson Ape. of Wm. Price on the following certificate viz. We the  
 Comm<sup>r</sup>. for adjusting claims to unpatented lands in the Counties of Monong<sup>ia</sup>  
 Yo. hog. & Ohio, do hereby certify that Wm. Price is entitled to 400 acres of land in the  
 County of Yo. hogonia on the Waters of Chartiers Creek to include his actual settle-  
 ment made in the year 1768.
