



In Virtue of a Warrant dated the 23^d day of July 1764 conveyed the 19th day of June 1864 to William Phillips the above described Tract of land situate in Lackawanna Township (formerly Northampton) Now Pike County adjoining and on the South West side of land surveyed to John Phillips containing four hundred and six acres and eighty five perches and the allowance of six per Cent for Roads &c.
