



A draught of a tract of land situate in Jackson Township, Susquehanna County, adjoining lands of Othaniel Phelps on the North West - the Susquehanna River on the North East - Vacant land on the South East and lands late of Henry Boyer and Jacob Peterman on the South West. Surveyed the fifth day of August A.D. 1856 for Othaniel Phelps in pursuance of his improvement Warrant bearing date the fifth day of March A.D. 1856 containing Eleven Acres and twenty six perches with the allowance of six per cent for Roads &c - containing an improvement of about three acres commenced about the first day of June A.D. 1857 and occupied by an actual tenant under the said Phelps.
