



By Virtue of a Warrant dated the 16th day of October 1788 Surveyed the 5th of October 1796 (by Anthony Crothers Esq^e) to John Gardner & the above described tract of land situate on a Creek emptying into Susquehanna at the Great Bend in Northampton County (now Wayne County) Containing two Hundred and eight acres and one Hundred and forty seven perches and the Allowance of six per Cent &c - Examined and Certified by me the 16th day of July 1806.
