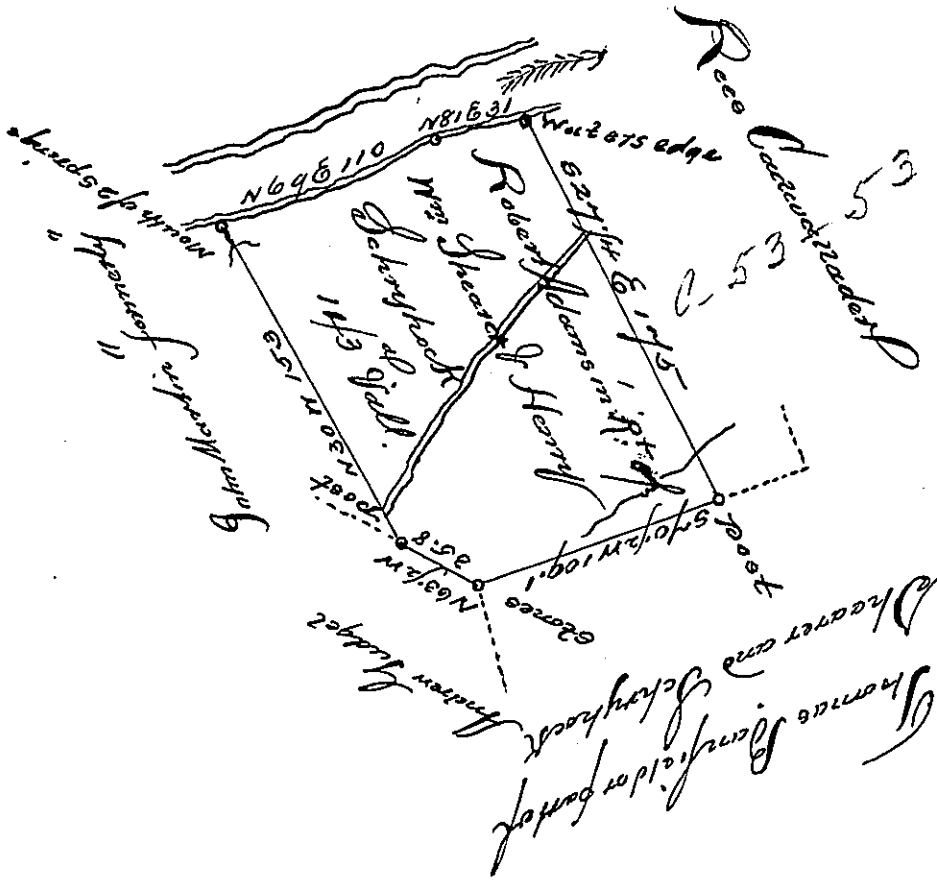


Note, this survey extends to the water



Situate on the East side of Monongahela River about a mile above Brownsville ^{in Section Township Fayette County} and is part of a Tract of land formerly surveyed and Returned to the said Adams and Thomas Shain, and Conveyed by William Schooley, a part whereof by a decree of the Honorable Board of Property dated the seventh day of February one thousand seven hundred and ninety-one was adjudged to William Schooley. I have at the request of the said Robert Adams, conformed the present return to the effect of the said decree, in order that he may obtain a patent for the same in his own right Thomas Shain who has hitherto been a partner with him in said land and for whom as such I have heretofore made return of survey, having sold or Released to the said Robert Adams
