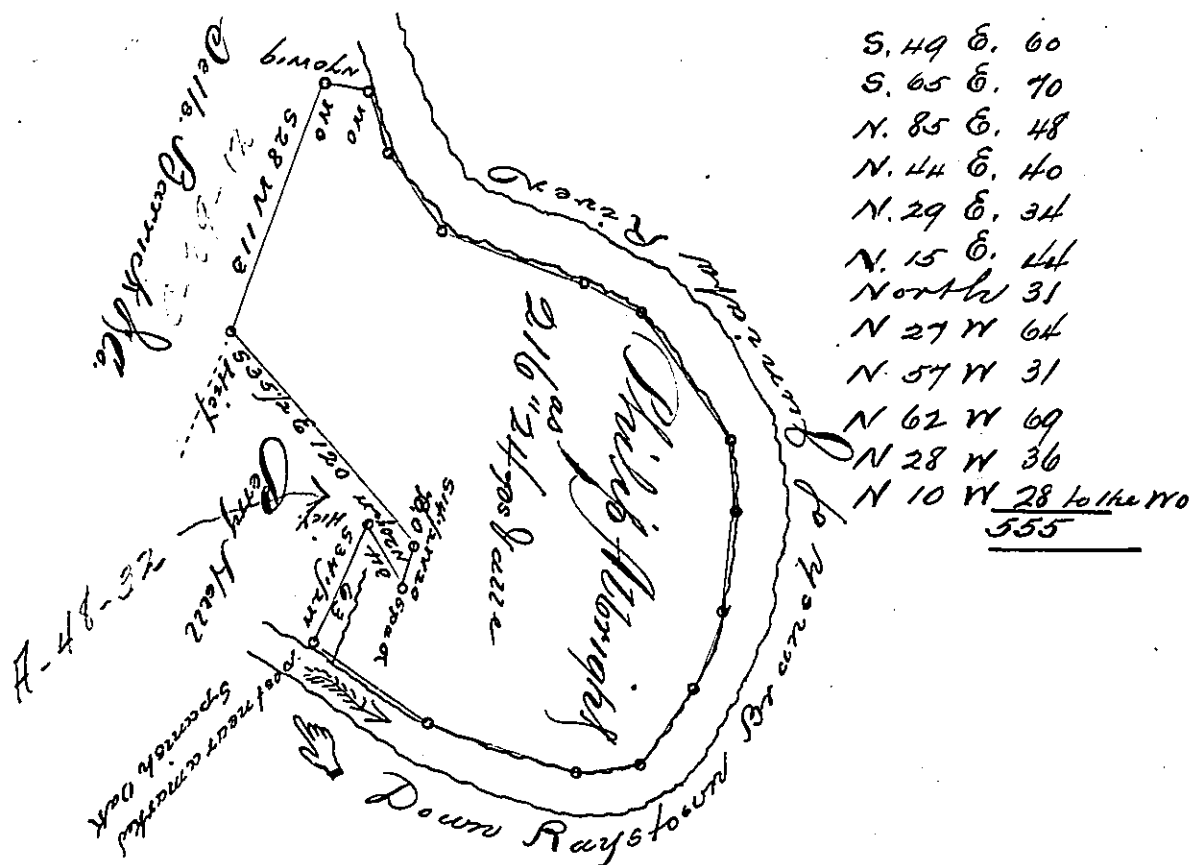


Beginning at a post near a marked

20<sup>th</sup> day of June, 1796.
