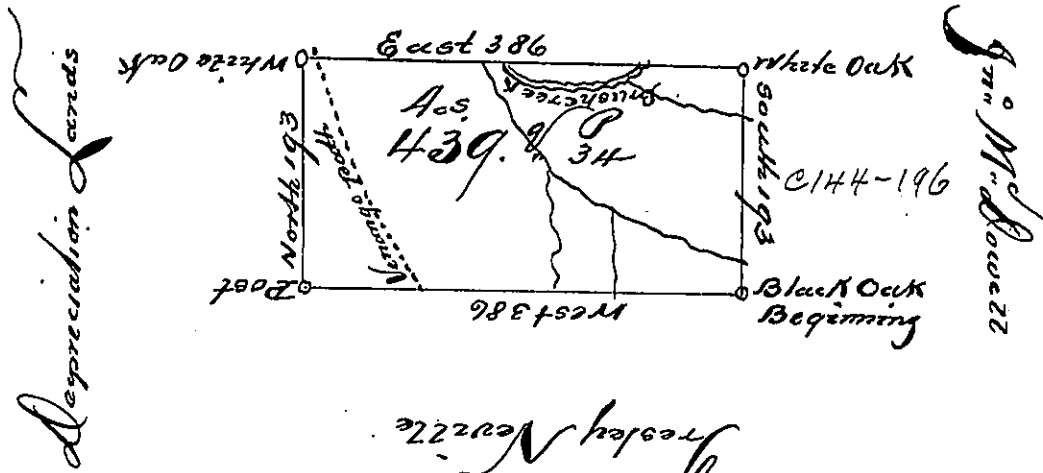

The above is a Draught of a survey made May 20th 1794, in pursuance of a warrant granted to Peter Andrairi, dated February the tenth day, 1794, for 400 acres of land. Situate where the Vernango Path crosses the first large stream that enters into Big Beaver Creek about 18 miles from Pittsburg, on the south side of said Creek, and adjoining the Cranberry plains North and West of the river Ohio in District N^o 9. Containing four hundred thirty nine acres and thirty four poles, together with the usual allowance of six ft. Cent for Roads and Highways (Called White Oak flat)
