


Wm Bingham T6. 2245



Situate on Kegina Creek four miles East of the District T6. 5 in the last purchase District T6. 4 - Surveyed July the fourth 1793 in pursuance of a War rank to William Bingham Esquire T6. 2244 Dated the twelfth day of December 1792 for 1000 acres.

Containing eleven hundred acres and the usual allowance of six per cent for Roads &c.
