



Situate on the waters of Everts in Cumberland valley township Bedford county, containing 166 as 126 ps and allowance of 6 percent for roads &c. being composed of two tracts, the one containing 69 1/4 acres and allowance, Surveyed the 6th. of May 1796 in pursuance of a warrant granted in the name of Michael Rien dated the 1st. of September 1794. the other containing 97 acres 84 perches and allowance Surveyed the 5th. of November 1808 in pursuance of a warrant granted in the name of Michael Rine dated the 29th. of April 1808, and resurveyed in pursuance of an order of resurvey granted by the Board of Property dated the 1st. of November 1851. Examined copied and returned (to be patented to James Cessna) the 28th. of November 1851.
