 of land was surveyed for Joseph Culbertson on his actual settlement and improvement on
 the 3^d day of April 1805. Then in H^o Ocean Township - Resurveyed on the 5th day of November
 1806 and returned by virtue of John Culbertson warrant dated the 1st day of October 1805 and it
 does not appear from the Warrant or survey books to have been hitherto otherwise claim-
 ed or appropriated - Jan^y 4. 1858 -
