



A draught of a part of a tract of land in Washington Township Erie County surveyed the 5th day of January 1838 for Edward Williams by virtue of the actual settlement residence and improvement of Joseph Culbertson for use of John Culbertson dec^d. Containing one hundred and six acres and one hundred and seventeen perches and six per cent allowance for Roads &c marked in the map of said township with the letters b.b.---

It appears from the survey book that the whole tract of land above represented was surveyed to Joseph Culbertson on the 5th day of April 1805 and Resurveyed on John Culbertson's warrant dated 15th Oct 1805. on the 5th Nov^r 1806, and it does not appear from the Warrant or Survey Books to have been hitherto otherwise claimed or appropriated.
