



Situate in Barre Township in the County of Huntingdon on the path called Hoines' road leading from Stone Valley to Kishacoquillis valley, adjoining Land of Reuben Hoines, Jonathan Austin and others on the waters of Standing Stone Creek. Containing four hundred and one acres and one hundred and forty one perches with the usual allowance of six p Cent for roads to be surveyed for John Wright the 10 July 1795 in pursuance of a warrant Dated 8 June 1795.
