



A Draught of a Tract of Land called wheatfield situate on the Waters of Clearfield Creek about a Mile South from that part of the West Branch of Susquehanna which lies half way between Chingleclamouche & the Mouth of Chest Creek which is known by the name of the great Bottom adjoining Lands of Asaph Wilson and others in the County of Bedford Containing two hundred & thirty two Acres & the usual allowance of six p Cent for Roads &c. Surveyed the third Day of June 1776 for John Rodney of Sussex County in pursuance of an Order N^o 3220 Dated the 13th Day of May 1769 by
