The Lines of the Land which he held by Patent were not Agreeable to the Boundaries therein Mentioned therefore at his Request I have Examined them And laid Down a true Draught of the Whole Containing One Thousand and thirty Acres & a quarter of an Acres besides All<sup>os</sup> of 6 p Cent.
