



A Draught of a Tract of Land called the Vineyard, Situate "in the long Limestone Valley where the Indian or Traders path passes from the Bald Eagles "Nest towards Frankstown" adjoining and southward of Land Surveyed for John Burns, on both sides of Trout Run where the above mentioned path crosses the said Run, in Cumberland County, Containing Three Hundred and Twenty four acres and the Usual Allowance of Six per Cent for Roads &c. Surveyed October 24th 1770 for Roger Flahavan: in pursuance of an Order N^o 1124 Dated April 3^d 1769.
