



A Draught of a Tract of Land situate on Delaware run in Turbutt Township in the County of Northumberland &c Surveyd by William Scull (the then Deputy Surveyor of the District on the 4th day of August 1769, & Resurveyd by me Agreeable to the Old Lines on the 20th day of January 1790, for Jacob Stoute in Pursuance of his Order No 1990 bearing date the third day of April 1769, Containing One Hundred & Eighty One Acres & three Quarters with the Allowance of Six p Cent for Roads &c - Letter A was included (by W^m Scull) in Jacob Stoutes Survey as above Represented & some time after taken off Stoutes & added to Matthew Currys Survey, it therefore Leaves Stoute 181 3/4 Acres &c
