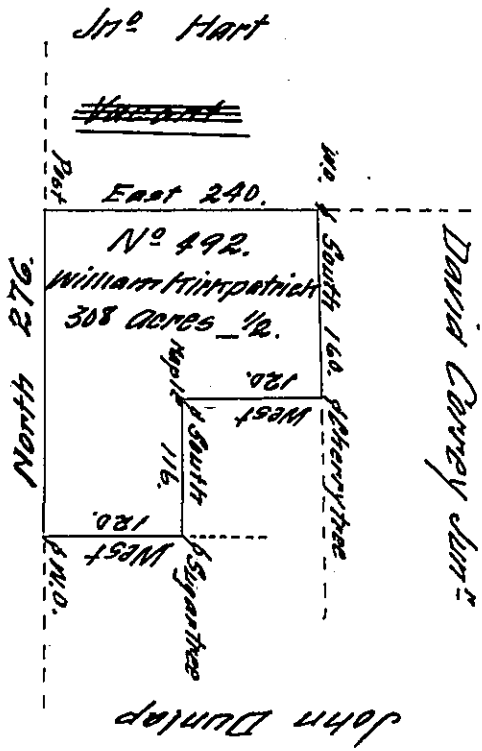


The line of District No. 6. James Potter Esq. D.S.
