



A Draught of a Tract of Land Situate in White Hall Township in the County of Northampton (formerly Bucks) in the Province of Pennsylvania. Contain- ing One Hundred and Eighty Seven Acres and 72 perches of Land toge- ther with the usual Allowance at Six per Cent for Roads. That was surveyed Unto Adam Mowre, in Pursuance of a Warrant granted by the Hon^{ble} Proprietaries Unto Felix Arner. Dated at Philadelphia on the fourth Day of November Anno-1749.

The Said Arner Sold his Right to the said Warrant unto the Said Adam Mowre.
