



*A Draught of a Lot of Ground in the Town of Carlisle in the County of Cumberland marked in a General Plan of said Town No. 178. Situate on the East side of Hanover Street Between Lowther Street and North Street.*

*Containing in Breadth North and South on Hanover Street Sixty feet and in Length East and West Two hundred and forty feet. Bounded westward with Hanover Street aforesaid. Northward with Lot No. 179. Eastward with Lot No. 191 and Southward with Lot No. 177.*

*Returned into the Secretary's Office the 13th day of July 1772 By Warrant granted the same day to John Greigh*
