



A Draught of a Tract of land called Providence Situate on a large branch of Nescopeck Creek about three miles Eastward of the Indian path leading from the Mouth of said Creek to Fort Allen adjoining land Surveyed for Isaac Cox Junr. & others in the County of Northumberland containing three hundred & Sixty two acres and one quarter of an Acre besides the usual allowance for Roads &c. Surveyed the 10th Day of November 1773 for John Cox the younger in pursuance of a Warrant Dated the 6th day of August 1773
