



A Draught of a tract of land situated about fifteen <sup>miles</sup> north of the Huntington Settlement on the east branch of Fishing Creek including the heads of a small run rising & sinking in the same valley, in which, there is an old Indian clearing, in the county of ~~Northampton~~ Luzerne containing four hundred acres and eighteen & eight tenths perches and allowance &c. Surveyed for Andrew Clark the tenth day of April A.D. seventeen hundred and one by William Montgomery, D.S. my predecessor, by virtue of a warrant dated the twenty sixth day of February 1793. as appears, by the original Draft in my Office, which survey I have examined and corrected.
