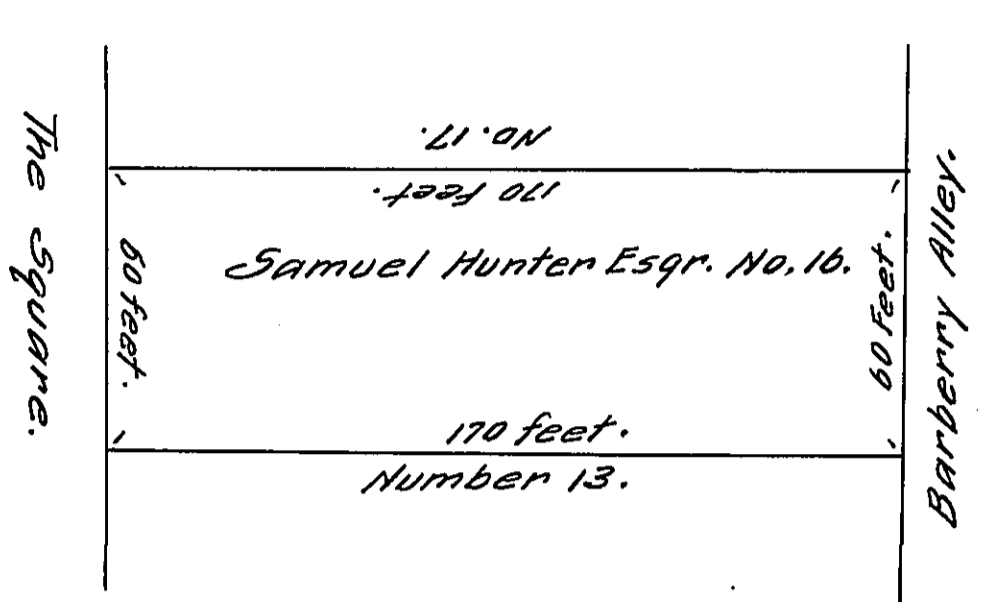

In pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16th day of June 1772 A Survey was made on the 3d of July following of a certain Lot of Ground in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland, marked in the general plan of said Town Sixteen and granted to Samuel Hunter Esqr. containing in Breadth East and West Sixty feet and in length North and South One hundred and Seventy feet, bounded Westward by Lot number Thirteen Southward by Barberry Alley, Eastward by Lot number Seventeen and Northward by the public Square, as by the general plan of said Town remaining in the Surveyor Generals office will appear. dno. Lukens. S. G.
