A Draught of a Tract of Land Called Womblesdorff Situate on a Run that emptys into the North East Branch of Susq<sup>a</sup> River on the southerly side of said River about Eight Miles above Catawassey and about a mile and a half from the Mouth of said Run adjoining land Surveyed for Philip Baker and Conrad Graff. in the County of Northumberland. containing three hundred and forty Nine Acres and a quarter of an Acre besides the usual allowance of 6<sup>th</sup> Cent for Roads & <sup>th</sup>. Surveyed the 15<sup>th</sup> Day of September 1773 for Charles Hemitch. In Pursuance of a Warrant Dated the 25<sup>th</sup> Day of February 1773.
