



The Above is a Draught of a Survey made Dec<sup>r</sup>. 10<sup>th</sup> 1784 in Pursuence of a Warrant granted to John Brown Dated the 13<sup>th</sup> Day of Oct. 1784 Situate on the Waters of Ten Mile Creek Joining land survey<sup>d</sup> for George Lattimore in Washington County Called Horse Pen containing four hundred Acres with the Usual Allowance for Roads &c.
