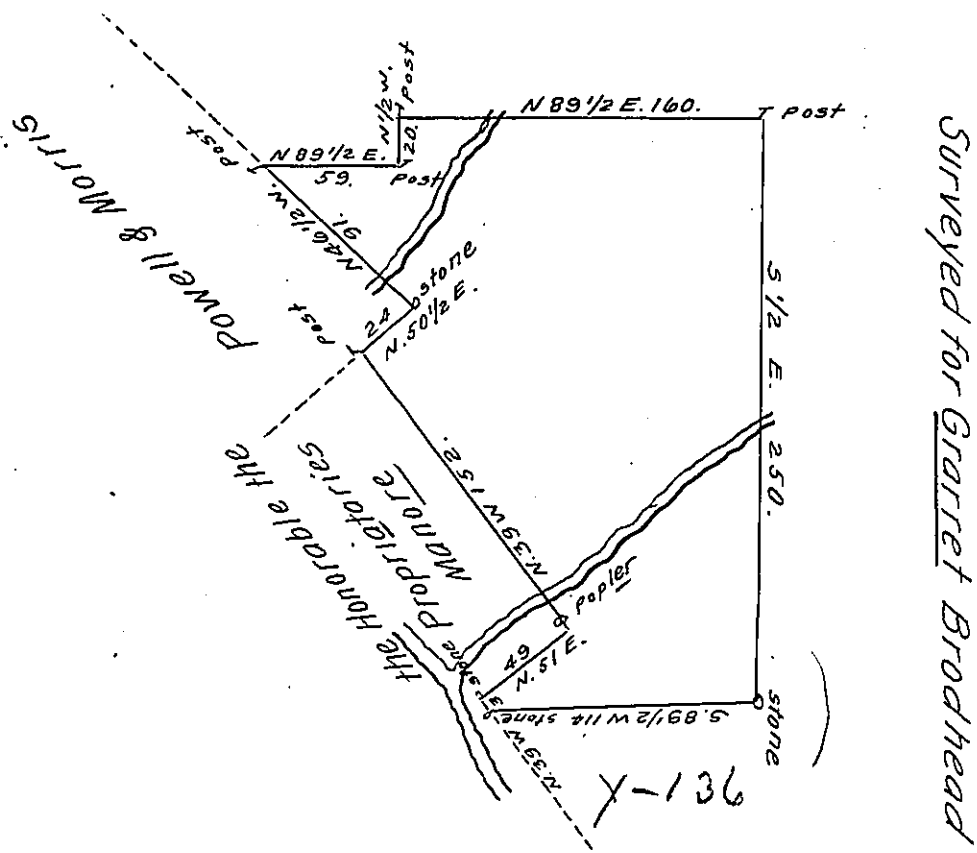


Land Surveyed for Garret Brodhead



By Virtue of an Application N<sup>o</sup> 817 dated the 14<sup>th</sup> August 1765.  
 Surveyed the 23<sup>d</sup> September 1795 to Frederick Venderlip the  
 above described Tract of Land situate on Brodheads Creek  
 about twelve Miles from ford Penn in Lower smithfield Township  
 Northampton County. Containing two hundred & Nine acres, twen-  
 ty nine perches & the allowance of Six <sup>7</sup>/<sub>100</sub> Cent & <sup>9</sup>/<sub>100</sub>.  
 the Same land is Granted to Joseph Leaman }  
 dated the 16<sup>th</sup> February 1793. } <sup>7</sup>/<sub>100</sub> Geo. Palmer. D.S.
