Surveyed on the 26th day of October 1785 in Pursuance of a Warrant No 169 Granted to Timothy Pickering, Samuel Hodgdon, Duncan Ingraham Jun^r and Tench Coxe Dated at Phila^d the 17th day of May 1785 for One thousand Acres.
