Containing three hundred & fourteen Acres & One hundred & twenty five Perches besides the usual allowance of Six Cent for Roads &c Surveyed the 5<sup>th</sup> day of June 1775 for Benjamin Poultney In Pursuance of a Warrant dated the 13<sup>th</sup> day of October 1774.
