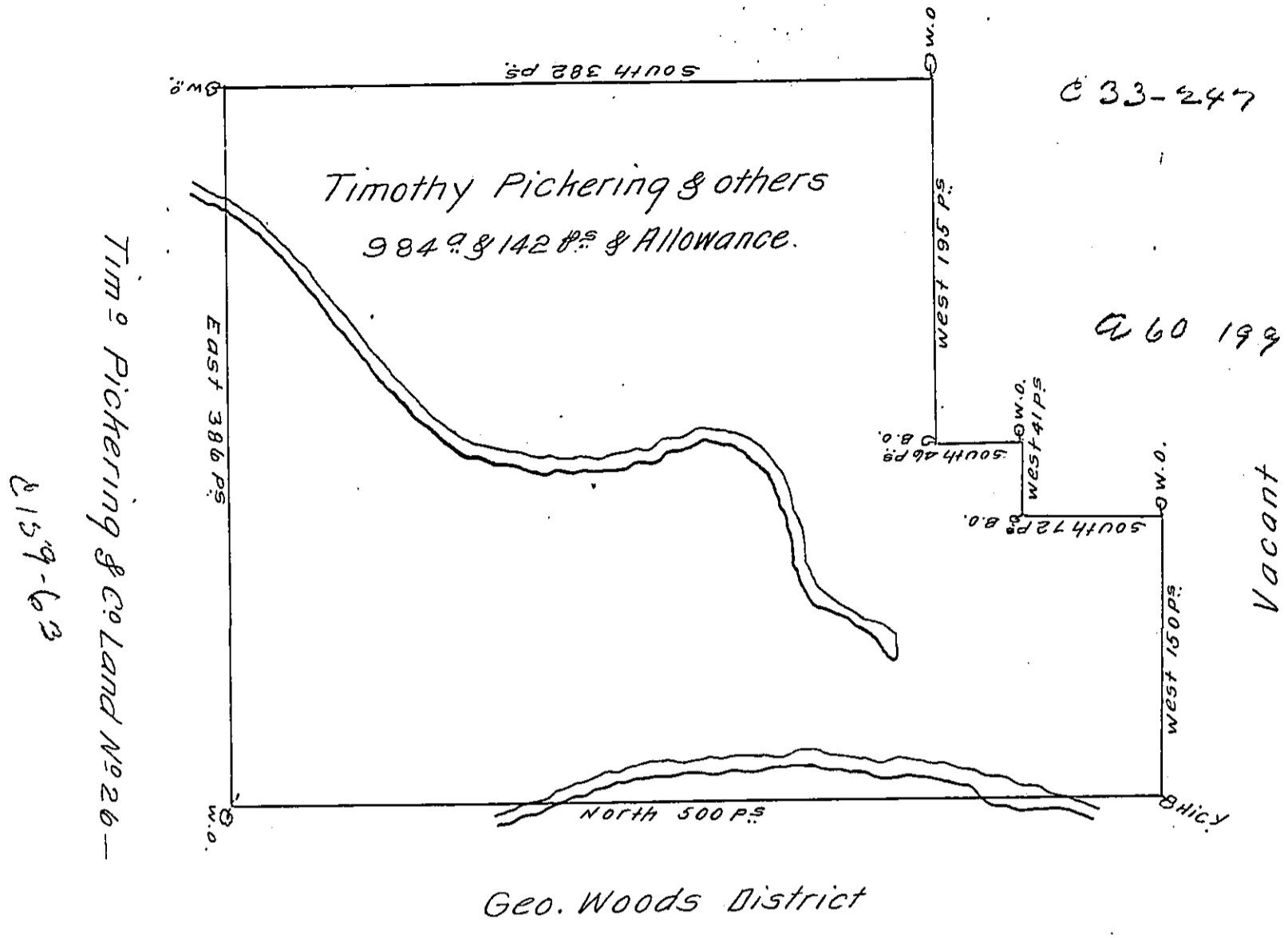

Situate About half a Mile South of Tobys Creek & Adjoining my North Line in Northumberland County. By Warrant for 1000 A. No 54 Dated the 17<sup>th</sup> Day of May 1785.
