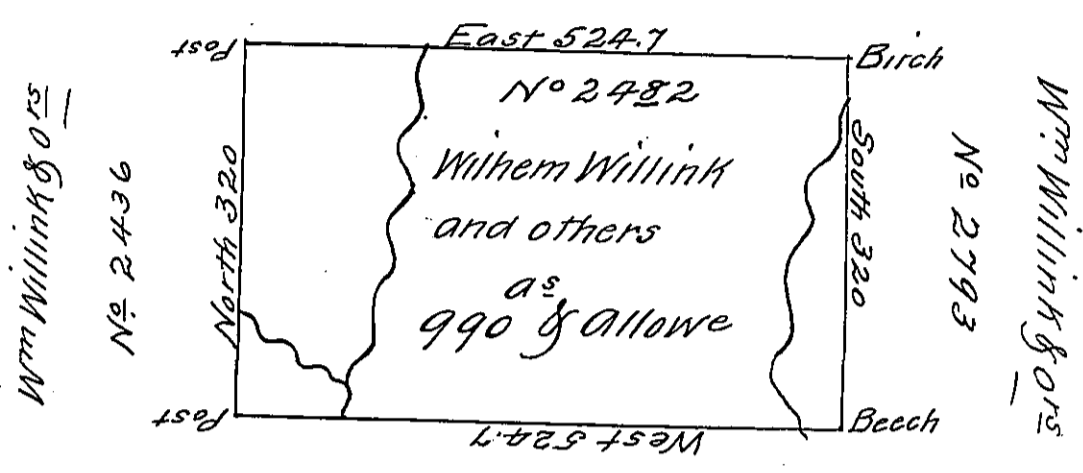

Surveyed the Eleventh day of July 1793 in persuance of a Warrant to Wilhem Willink, Nicholaas Vanstaphorst, Christian Van Eghen, Hendrik Vollenhoven & Rutger Jan Schimmepenninck of Amsterdam, No 2492 for 900 ^{as} Dated the twelfth day of December 1792, Containing Nine Hundred & Ninety ^{as} & the Usual Allowe of Six pr Ct for Roads & C.
