 & Twenty Perches to a Post in ye Line of John Millions Land thence by the  
 same Land West South West Sixty four Perches to a Corner Stone thence  
 North North Westerly by Isaac Vernons Land Four Hundred and Twenty  
 Perches to the place of Beginning, Containing One Hundred Fifty three  
 Acres with Allowance for Roads &c.
