



N.B. The tract A B C D E F G H was surveyed & returned to Richard Stevens on his warrant dated 1. September 1787. The tract A B C D E F G H K L M was surveyed to Isaiah Hughes on his warrant dated the 29 May 1792 in this survey there was too much included therefore could not be all accepted on the warrant. The above tracts now claimed by one person & to enable him to hold the whole survey the small tract G H I was excluded from Isaiah Hughes' tract and annexed to the first survey of Richard Stevens the remainder of Isaiah Hughes tract is returned on his warrant containing now AS 110 & allowance

Situate in Schuylkill township Berks County cont<sup>g</sup> four hundred fifty acres & the allowance of six  $\frac{1}{2}$ -cent resurveyed the 5<sup>th</sup> November 1805 to Richard Stevens in pursuance of a warrant dated the 1<sup>st</sup> September 1787.
