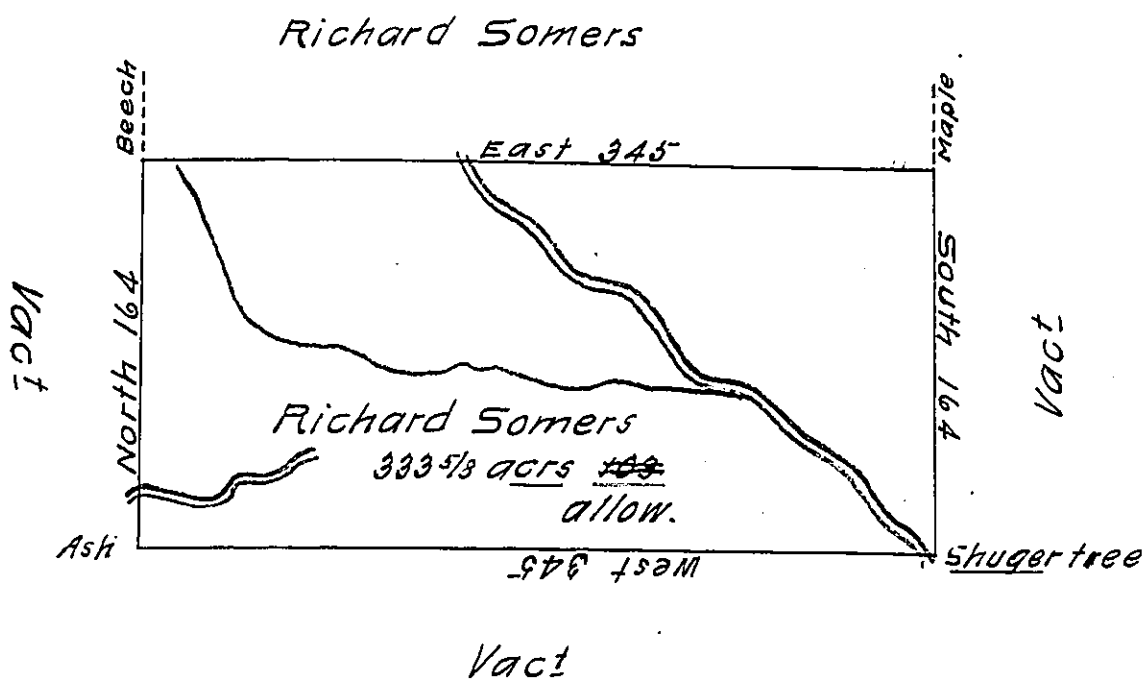

Surveyed on the 24th day of October Anno Dom. 1785 in persuance of a warrant N^o 124 granted to Richard Somers dated at Phila the 17th day of May Anno Dom. 1785 for three hundred and twenty five acres.
