



A Draught of a Tract of land called— Situate on the Southerly side of the North East Branch of Susquehanna River joining land Surveyed for Isaac Gray on the Waters of Nanticoke Creek in the County of Northumberland. containing three hundred and one Acres and three Quarters of an Acre. besides the Usual allowance of Six & Cent for Roads &c. Surveyed the first day of August 1774 for Isaac Jones in Pursuance of a Warrant dated the 17<sup>th</sup> day of August 1773.
