



A Draught of a Tract of land called — Situate on the East side of the North East branch of Susquehanna River about Nine Miles and three Quarters below the mouth of Owego—adjoining a Survey made for the Honorable the proprietaries in the County of Northumberland containing three hundred and eight Acres and one hundred and forty perches besides the usual allowance of Six $\frac{1}{2}$ Cent for Roads &c. Surveyed the Tenth day of October 1774 for Andrew Allen in pursuance of a Warrant dated the 17th day of March 1774.
