



A Draught of a Tract of Land called— Situate on the Westerly Side of the North East Branch of Susquehanna River partly opposite an Island called Wyalosing Island and adjoining and below a Tract of Land Surveyed for Joseph Morris in the County of Northumberland containing three hundred & Ten Acres besides the usual allowance of Six & Cent for Roads &th Surveyed the 16th day of September 1774 for Joseph Ball in Pursuance of a Warrant dated the 16th day of March 1774.
